

Be a BSA Instructor for Climbing & C.O.P.E. !

Salmen Scout Reservation needs more Climbing & C.O.P.E. Instructors! When trained, you can facilitate C.O.P. E. or Climbing weekend activities for your unit, or serve on camp staff. You must be registered with a Troop or a Venturing Crew, and be at least 16 years old to become an Instructor in Training, 18 to be a Level I Instructor, or 21 to be a Level II Instructor.

The Climbing / C.O.P.E. Committee will offer training courses in Fall and Spring to give you the knowledge and skills needed to become a BSA Instructor. The courses involve a combination of classroom work and hand-on training in skills for climbing, rappelling, rigging and rescues for Climbing Instructors, and similar high and low course skills for C.O.P.E. Instructors. The total training time is spread over two or three weekends, plus service time during the year. We encourage instructors to be cross-trained for both C.O.P.E. and Climbing.
