

# Are you Ready for Shooting Sports?



## NRA Rifle, Shotgun and RSO Instructor Training

This is a unique opportunity for Louisiana Boy Scouts of America Leaders and Volunteers to earn the certifications necessary to run shooting sports programs for your scouts. The NRA Rifle, Shotgun and RSO Instructor Courses will be held over a two weekend session for current Louisiana Boy Scout Adult Leaders and Volunteers. Upon completion, participants will have the knowledge to serve as BSA Rifle or Shotgun Merit Badge Counselors, serve as a Range Safety Officer for shooting sports and to hold NRA Rifle or Shotgun safety courses and events for Scouters and non-Scouters. The course will be comprised of the NRA Basic Instructor Training, the NRA Rifle and Shotgun Instructor course and the Range Safety Officer.

### Registration Information and Fees:

**All equipment and course materials will be provided for class.** The student fee of \$35.00 per weekend program will cover camping and food. Students completing the course will be asked to sign a BSA Shooting Sports Commitment form. This form from you states you agree to support your councils shooting sports program. Typically BSA councils would like to see program participants volunteer in three shooting sports program events over the next two years (Merit Badge weekend, shooting sports weekend program, day or week-long events during a winter or summer camp) in return for this opportunity. The NRA Instructor Program typically costs \$200.00 per instructor course. *This course is offering eligible participants a \$475.00 discount.* Registration will be limited to the first 50 registrants. The student camping/food fee of \$35.00 per weekend program is non-refundable and must be prepaid to ensure your spot in the course. For students that do not pre-register, the walk-in registration fee is \$100.00. Students should only bring their personal items like sunscreen, camp chair, mosquito spray and camp gear. Instructor Candidates will participate in both indoor and outdoor exercises including shooting qualification time on the range. Students must attend the entire course (Rifle 14 hours, Shotgun 12 hours, RSO 9 hours, BIT 6 hours), pass the prequalification shooting, Instructor Evaluation and the Instructor discipline tests to complete the course.
